
UNIQUE FEATURES OF THE PROGRAM

- » Applicants without a Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) can enroll without having to take any additional preparatory courses
- » Field visits and practical application of lessons alongside theoretical discussions
- » Learning Management System (LMS) for content exchange, online forum, quiz, customizable course interface etc.
- » Unlimited access to online resources including journals, research papers and dissertations



ELIGIBILITY

- » Individuals having at least the 4-year Bachelor with Honors Degree, 3-years (Hons./Pass) from any recognized university or a BE/MBBS/BDS/BSc. degree from Engineering University/Colleges/ Medical Colleges.
- A Master degree is compulsory for 2-years
 B.A. (PASS) applicants.
- » A candidate having one Master's degree already is also eligible to apply.
- » Candidates having 3rd Division/Class or CGPA below 2.50 at any level of their academic career are not eligible to apply.
- » Applicants with GED (General Education Development) will not be eligible to enroll.



COURSE STRUCTURE

- » After completion of 10 common core courses, a participant can choose to complete PGD or to take M.Ed.
- » The overall duration of completing the PGD program is 18-months (one and a half years), and the duration of completing M.Ed. is 24-months (two years). We are also offering one year customized PGD/ M.Ed. program

COURSE CREDITS

PGD students have to complete 10 core courses (27 credits) and the M.Ed. students, in addition to this, have to take the thesis (9 credits). Total 36 credits.
